- I am complete in Christ who is the head of all principality and power Col 2: 10.

- I seek those things which are above, where Christ sits at the right hand of God Col 3: 1.
- I have set my affection on things above and not only on this earth for my life is hidden with Christ in God Col 3: 2 3.
- I have put to death sinful attributes. I have nothing to do with sexual sins, impurity, lust, shameful devices and idolatry Col 3: 5.
- I have put off anger, rage, malicious behaviour, slander and dirty or filthy communication
 Col 3: 8.
- I do not tell lies for I have put off the old man and all its wicked deeds Col 3: 9.
- I have clothed myself with a brand new nature that is continually renewed in knowledge after the image of God Col 3: 10.
- I have clothed myself with tender hearted mercy, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness and longsuffering Col 3: 12.
- I forgive people even as Christ Jesus forgave me Col 3: 13.
- Above all, I have cloth myself with love which binds us all in perfect harmony Col 3: 14.
- The peace of God rules in my heart and I am always thankful Col 3: 15.
